

## WHAT ARE THE RULES OF THE ROAD?

- Operate only on streets with a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less.
- All laws and ordinances relating to alcohol and its use, including open container laws, shall apply.
- Abide by all traffic regulations applicable to automotive traffic.
- Lap belts shall be worn by all Operators and passengers age 15 or less, but are optional for Operators and passengers age 16 or older.
- Do not enter any intersection without yielding the right-of-way to any Vehicles, automobiles, or pedestrians.
- All Operators and passengers must remain seated at all times during operation of the PTV. No person shall sit on the lap of any operator or passenger during the operation of the PTV.
- Only Persons possessing a valid driver's license may Operate PTVs.
- All Operators of PTVs shall park only in marked parking spaces, not in landscaped areas or on sidewalks, or walkways.

## WHAT IS A PTV OR MODIFIED GOLF CART?

- **Personal Transportation Vehicle (“PTV”)**  
Any motor vehicle with a minimum of four wheels, capable of a maximum level ground speed of less than 20 miles per hour, with a maximum gross vehicle empty weight of 1,375 pounds, capable of transporting not more than eight persons. PTVs shall be operated only on roads with a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour.
- **Modified Golf Cart** means a Golf Cart that has been mechanically altered to meet the definition of a Personal Transportation Vehicle (PTV).
- **Golf Cart** means any motorized vehicle designed for the purpose and exclusive use of conveying one or more persons and equipment to play the game of golf in an area designated as a golf course. For such a vehicle to be considered a golf car or golf cart, its speed on a paved level surface shall not exceed 15 miles per hour. Golf carts shall not be operated outside of a golf course or on any road in conjunction with regular vehicular traffic.

Golf Carts are **not** permitted.  
PTVs and Modified Golf Carts are permitted on roads with a speed limit of **25mph or less** upon registration with the city.

## WHAT EQUIPMENT IS REQUIRED?

- Braking System Including Parking Brake
- Reverse Warning Device
- Main Power Switch
- Headlamps
- Tail Lamps
- Reflex Reflectors
- Horn
- Rear-view Mirror
- Safety Warning Labels
- Hip restraints and Hand Holds
- Lap belts (only required for riders 15 and under)

PTVs and Modified Golf Carts ***shall not be driven on sidewalks and trail segments,*** or any area not generally intended for vehicular traffic

## HOW DO I REGISTER?

Registration opens January 1st, 2019.  
Enforcement of the ordinance begins  
**March 1st, 2019.**

**1)** Download a Registration Form and Supporting Documents from our website located in the Community Development section ([www.woodstockga.gov](http://www.woodstockga.gov))

**OR**

Stop by the City of Woodstock Annex to fill out a Registration Form  
(12493 Hwy 92)

**2)** Drop off your completed Registration form at the City Annex to receive:

- A Decal with your Registration Number
- PTV and Modified Golf Cart Ordinance
- Map showing speed limits in the downtown area

**3)** Attach your Decal to the driver's side rear fender and read the ordinance in full
